About the Hi'ikua Helpline

The Kamehameha Schools Hi'ikua Helpline is a confidential service to assist students with reporting safety issues. The Hi'ikua Helpline is available 24 hours a day throughout the year. The Hi'ikua Helpline is administered by a third party, EthicsPoint, to maintain confidentiality. Reporters are encouraged to identify themselves in order for school personnel to ensure efficient attention to concerns or issues. Anonymous reports will be accepted and reviewed to the extent possible.

Kamehameha Schools does not tolerate retaliation against anyone because he or she, in good faith, reports a concern. It is a violation to knowingly report false allegations. A student or staff member who is found to report a false allegation may be subject to disciplinary action as appropriate.
