European Union Voice Your Concern Program



Background

In the EU, the Voice Your Concern Program extends to external persons as well as Medtronic employees, including:

Volunteers

- Non-Executive Directors
- Self-employed persons
- Persons supervised by contractors or suppliers
- Former employees
- Job applicants (ie. future employees in cases where information of an infringement has been acquired during period of recruitment or pre-contractual negotiations).
- Supporters/facilitators of the whistleblowers
- Journalists
- Shareholders
- Members of the administrative, management or supervisory bodies within the organisation Trainees (paid/unpaid)
- Third party groups who are connected to the reporting person (eg: colleagues/family members)MediatorsLegal entities that the reporting person owns, works for or is otherwise associated with in a work-related context.

Breaches of EU Law that are within the EU Voice Your Concern remit include:

- 1. Breaches affecting the financial interests of the EU (fraud)
- 2. Breaches relating to the internal market (incl. competition and State aid rules)
- 3. Breaches of the specific EU law acts listed in the Annex to the Directive and relating to the following policy areas:
 - public procurement;
 - financial services, products and markets, and prevention of money laundering and terrorist financing;
 - product safety and compliance;
 - transport safety;
 - protection of the environment;
 - radiation protection and nuclear safety;
 - food and feed safety, animal health and welfare;
 - public health;
 - consumer protection;
 - protection of privacy and personal data, and security of network and information systems.
